RULES OF SYMPOSIUM  
SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT AND EVALUATION

The symposium is open to the participation of academics and researchers related to the subject. For this, abstracts of 300-800 words containing the purpose, method, resources to be used and possible findings should be sent to [deprenhukuku@medipol.edu.tr](mailto:deprenhukuku@medipol.edu.tr) as an attached file until 12.04.2021. Paper proposals will be evaluated by the Symposium Scientific Committee by blind peer review, taking into account the symposium topics, compliance with scientific criteria and the originality of the study. Accepted paper proposals will be announced to the relevant parties on 20.04.2021.

PAPER ABSTRACT/FULL TEXT WRITING RULES

1. In the paper, the title should be written centered, in bold capital letters, and the name and the surname of the author should be just below it, justified to the right. The unnumbered footnote to be placed at the bottom of the page should contain the academic title, institution, ORCID number and e-mail address in the given order.
2. The full text of the paper should also include a 300-800-word abstract in Turkish and English in font size 10 after the title and the name of the author. The title should also be included in the abstract in English.
3. After the abstract, 3 to 5 keywords in Turkish and English and references should be added.
4. The font of the texts should be Times New Roman and the font size 12. The font sizes of tables, footnotes and the references used is 10.
5. The paper should be in Microsoft Word format and written in justification according to A4 paper size. 2.5 cm space should be left from the bottom, top, right and left of the page; 1.25 cm space should be left in the footnote and header.
6. No line spacing should be left in paragraphs, and the following should be used: indent: 0 cm, spacing: first 6 pt - then 6 pt and line spacing: single line.
7. If the reference will be indicated under the text (footnote); author's name and surname, name of work, the person preparing the work for publication (editor), translator's or illustrator's name and surname, volume, issue, edition and publication information (volume number, issue number, edition number, series name, place of publication, publisher, date of publication), volume number and page numbers should be provided in the given order.
8. Tables and figures should be numbered individually, and just below the table or figure, the reference should be specified in 10 pt.
9. Original documents, pictures, maps and similar visual materials that are not directly related to the text should not be included in the text unless required, and they should be numbered and added to the end of the text. High resolution images should be further sent in digital copies.
10. Presentations to be made at the symposium should not exceed 20 minutes and should preferably be supported by relevant visual materials.
11. Papers to be sent to the symposium must be original work that has not been published in another academic event or has not been at the evaluation stage for publication.

Presentations made in the symposium will be audiotaped and videotaped, and can be broadcast in places deemed appropriate by the Symposium Organizing Committee.

PUBLICATION OF PAPERS

All abstracts presented at the symposium will be published in an e-book format with ISBN. In case of acceptance of the abstracts, the participants who submit the abstracts are deemed to have approved the publication. In addition, the full text of the papers will be published in the Book of Proceedings of Symposium. No royalties will be paid to the authors for the abstract and full text publication.
