

Erasmus 2023 Project Results

1. Evaluation Criteria:

In the final score results, the following evaluation criteria were applied.

Out of the total of 100 (final score) points:

- Academic Success Level (GANO): 50%
- Language Level: 50%

Out of the total of 100 (Final score) points,

The stated points have been applied to the following situations;

- To the children of martyrs and war veterans; +15 points
- Disabled students (Provided that the disability is documented): + 10 points
- To the students for whom protection, care or accommodation decision has been taken within Social Services Law No. 2828: + 10 points
- Participating in mobility in the country of citizenship: - 10 points
- Having benefitted from the mobility before (with or without grant): -10 points
- Applying for both mobilities at the same time (point deduction is applied to the student's choice of mobility): -10 points
- Not continuing with the mobility without giving a timely renouncing notice: -10 points
- Not participating in the mobility-related meetings/orientations without an excuse (implemented when applied for Erasmus again): -5 points
- Not taking the language exam without an excuse (implemented when applied for Erasmus again): -5 points
- Submitting the acceptance letter during internship mobility application: +10 points
- Students who apply for Erasmus+ student mobility and have first and second-degree relatives* (or themselves) who live in one of the ten earthquake-damaged provinces (Adana, Adiyaman, Diyarbakır, Gaziantep, Hatay, Kahramanmaraş, Kilis, Malatya, Osmaniye, and Şanlıurfa), but who are registered in higher education institutions with ECHE in different provinces: +10 points

2. Preferences:

The preference process will be held online between **6-24 April 2023**.

Only students entitled to go within the scope of study mobility (associate/undergraduate/Master's degree / PhD students) will complete the online preference form.

Students entitled to go to internship mobility (associate/undergraduate/Master's degree/PhD students) will not complete the online preference form as they will find the institution where they will do their internship.

Students can choose within the available quotas.

In the form, you can choose a **maximum of 3 universities**. Therefore, when making your choices, you should choose the university you want to go to in the first place.

You should fill out the preference form once. Students who filled out the form more than once must contact the Erasmus Office via e-mail.

If a student, who has previously benefitted from mobility, applies for both study and internship simultaneously, a deduction of “-20” points will be applied for the type of mobility they previously benefitted from, and “-10” for the second type of mobility they applied for.

Before making a choice, we recommend you review the university website you want to visit, have information on the language of instruction, if any extra documents may be requested, and check the campus and its conditions.

Candidates who do not fill out the preference form will be deemed to have renounced their rights.

Placement results will be determined according to the students who have chosen the universities.

Those who want to renounce their rights during the placements can submit their requests to the Erasmus Office via e-mail.

After the preferences, the placement results will be announced on **May 3, 2023**.

*Students who will benefit from internship mobility within the scope of the **2023** project should send their internship acceptance letters/invitation letters to erasmus@medipol.edu.tr until **November 1, 2023**, at the latest. *(The deadline and time for submitting the acceptance/invitation letter are 31.10.2023 at 23:59.)*

The **orientation meeting** for the **students who have earned the right** to go will be held on the **Teams** system, and they will be given **information about the date**.

3. Results:

The announced result list is not the grant results. Within the scope of the **2023 Project**, the grants will be provided after informing about the distribution after it is allocated to our university.

After completing the signing process of the annual contribution agreement between the EU and Turkey, grant agreements are signed between our university and the Centre and the grants are allocated to the university. All students who leave before this period will benefit from the mobility without a grant, and visa letters and grant contracts will be arranged. Students cannot hold our University and the Centre responsible for any expenses made at this stage.

Students who want to **object** to the exam results can object to the English Proficiency Exam within **5 (five)** business days from the announcement of the results.

First, you must fill out the **objection petition** for your requests on the topic and then e-mail mdyardimci@medipol.edu.tr address. The Language School will evaluate your request; you and the Erasmus Office will be notified if any changes occur. [Click here](#) to visit the form.

If there are students whose grades change due to the official objection period, the list will be shared with students.

Students who **score 70 and above** will be **able** to choose. The information on the topic is in the announcement dated 17.02.2023.

* Only, within the scope of the 2023 project, if the grant arrives at our University earlier, you may have to submit an acceptance letter earlier than the announced time in order to calculate the grant distribution. In this case, the Erasmus Unit will be contacted.
