VOCATIONAL SCHOOL OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

Vocational School of Social Sciences continues its education and training activities at Istanbul Medipol University Kavacık North campus. Within the Vocational School, education is provided in a total of 14 programs, 13 of which are day school and 1 program is night school.

At the Vocational School, students are given an associate degree diploma after 2 years of education. Students take the courses in their curriculum in the first year and gain experience in the sector in addition to the second-year courses. Programs with vocational practice (vocational training or internship) in the curriculum gain skills in the sector for at least 36 working days in the fall, spring, or summer semesters. In this way, students acquire theoretical knowledge as well as up-to-date practical knowledge in their fields.

The language of instruction of our programs is Turkish.

Students who graduate from Vocational School programs have the opportunity to complete their associate degree education to undergraduate education by taking the External Transfer Exam (DGS) after completing their education.

In addition to the permanent lecturers at the Vocational School, lecturers from different academic units of Istanbul Medipol University contribute to the programs in order to carry out the education and training activities completely. In addition, for some courses that require specialized teaching, we receive support from middle and senior managers who are active in the sector and successful in their profession.

The curriculum includes applied courses such as banking products and services, bank accounting, insurance practices, as well as theoretical courses such as insurance law, banking law, commercial law, economics and business administration. Additionally, a course on interest-free finance and participatory banking, which has become increasingly important today and has become stronger with the involvement of deposit banks, is given on the structure and functioning of participation banking. In this context, the aim of the program is to train qualified workforce to meet the needs of the sector.

CIVIL AVIATION AND CABIN SERVICES

Civil Aviation Cabin Services program provides vocational education. It prepares students to become cabin officers. This program is an associate degree program with a rich content focused on practice. It explains the basic theoretical and practical knowledge of national and international civil aviation rules. The language of education is Turkish. Since the language of aviation is English, there are General English and Vocational English courses. As elective courses, there are also Spanish and German courses. There are special requirements to enroll in the Civil Aviation Cabin Services program. For registration, the candidate must have a criminal record certificate and a health report from a health institution authorized by the General Directorate of Civil Aviation, stating that the health condition is suitable for flight.

Requirements to practice this profession:

- Not having a Criminal Record or Criminal Record Archive Record,
- For women, it is necessary to be between 160-180 cm tall and not be overweight or too skinny.
- For men, it is necessary to be between 170-190 cm tall and not be overweight or too skinny.
- Being in good health for flight (they must obtain a report from health institutions authorized by the General Directorate of Civil Aviation stating that their health condition is suitable for flight)
- Not having tattoos or scars on parts of the body that will be visible when the cabin crew uniform is worn

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SOCIAL SERVICES

Social services are a set of systematic and programmed services that aim to prevent problems that develop beyond the control of individuals, families and societies in the environmental conditions they live in, to meet the needs of people and to increase social welfare. In this respect, social service is a profession based on human rights and social justice principles, supporting social change, aiming problem solving, empowerment and emancipation in human relations in order to improve the well-being of people, and intervening in the interaction points of people with their environment by making use of theories on human behaviour and social systems. Today, there is a greater need for social workers and social technicians in the face of increasing human problems and differentiating needs.

Istanbul Medipol University Vocational School of Social Sciences Social Services Program aims to train social technicians who are equipped with professional knowledge, values and skills, have ethical person responsibilities, and are successful in human relations. In this direction, the program curriculum has been prepared by considering the YÖK Social Work National Core Education Program (2020). With the professional practice courses, which have an important place in the curriculum, it is aimed that students can transfer the theoretical knowledge they have learned to practice in social service institutions for 12 weeks, three days a week in autumn and spring semesters.
