- **Speaking:** Communicate fluently and confidently in meetings, presentations, and discussions, enhancing their ability to express ideas and collaborate effectively.
- **Use of English:** Demonstrate a strong command of vocabulary and grammar, ensuring accuracy and professionalism in both academic and business contexts.
