DIRECTIVE ON DOUBLE MAJOR AND MINOR PROGRAMS
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A student may apply to the Double Major Diploma Program at the earliest at the beginning of the second semester and at the latest at the beginning of the third semester of the associate degree program in which they are enrolled.

Article 7 – (1) Undergraduate students may apply to Double Major Diploma Programs at both undergraduate and associate degree levels, whereas associate degree students may apply only to associate degree programs.

In order to apply to the Double Major Diploma Program, the student must:

- a) Be an undergraduate or associate degree student at Istanbul Medipol University.
- b) Have successfully completed all courses taken in their major program up to the semester in which they apply.
- c) Have a weighted cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 3.00 (76.66 out of 100) at the time of application and rank within the top 20% of the relevant year of their major diploma program.
- d) Students who are not within the top 20% of the achievement ranking may also apply to the Double

Major Program if their placement score is not lower than the base score of the program to which they wish to pursue a double major in the relevant year.

Applications to the Double Major Diploma Program must be submitted in person to the Secretariat of the Vocational School of Health Services between 24 August 2026 and 31 August 2026. Applications submitted by e-mail will not be taken into consideration.

3. Official document confirming that the student is within the top 20% of the achievement ranking
