

**COURSE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR THE FALL SEMESTER OF THE
2026–2027 ACADEMIC YEAR**

Course selection for the Fall Semester of the 2026–2027 Academic Year will be carried out through MEBİS between **September 9 and September 18, 2026**.

Important:

- **If you have an outstanding tuition fee balance, the courses you select through MEBİS cannot be assigned to your course registration.**
- **Since the courses you have selected cannot be assigned to you until your outstanding balance has been paid, you must contact the Student Accounting Unit of the Department of Administrative and Financial Affairs to resolve the issue.**

Course Registration procedures

- **Compulsory Courses:** Courses that must be completed in order to graduate.
- **Common Compulsory Courses:** Turkish Language I and II / Principles of Atatürk and History of the Turkish Revolution I and II.
- **Program-Specific Elective Courses:** Elective courses offered in upper years of the program
- **Optional Elective Courses:** Courses such as General Culture, Hobbies, etc.
- **Courses from Other Departments**
- **Failed Courses/Internships**

On the Course Selection screen, under the headings listed above, you will find the courses to be offered by our Faculty during the Fall Semester of the 2026–2027 Academic Year, the internships to be offered, and the courses/internships that you have failed and are required to retake.

First-year students are required to select the Common Compulsory Courses.

The compulsory courses **Turkish Language I and II** and **Principles of Atatürk and History of the Turkish Revolution I and II** are delivered through **distance education (UZEM)**.

Students who wish to take **Optional Elective Courses** must select courses listed under the Optional Elective Courses heading. During the Fall Semester of the 2026–2027 Academic Year, Optional Elective Courses will be offered at the Kavacık and Haliç Campuses. Since students will be assigned to courses according to available quotas, selections must be made accordingly. An Optional Elective Course that has previously been taken and successfully completed may only be selected again for the purpose of **improving the grade**.

K/P-2	Kavacık Campus / Course offered on Thursday.
K/CTS-1	Kavacık Campus / Course offered on Saturday.
H/C-2	Haliç Campus / Course offered on Friday.
H/CTS-1	Haliç Campus / Course offered on Saturday.

If an Optional Elective Course selected under the **“Failed”** courses tab is not opened, and you select another course to replace it during the **course registration/add-drop period**, the system will match the newly selected course with the failed course. You will remain responsible for the newly selected course, and you will have no further obligation regarding the previously selected course.

The validity of the course registration is subject to the course selections being approved by both the student and the academic advisor.

Students who have not completed their course registration may not attend any courses or practical sessions or take their examinations. Writing your name manually on existing class attendance lists and attending classes does not constitute course registration and has no validity whatsoever; such attendance shall be deemed null and void.
