

**FINAL REGISTRATION AND COURSE SELECTION PROCEDURES
FOR STUDENTS ADMITTED TO ALL DEPARTMENTS OF OUR
INSTITUTE FOR THE FALL SEMESTER OF THE 2026–2027
ACADEMIC YEAR WILL BE CARRIED OUT BETWEEN SEPTEMBER
21 AND SEPTEMBER 25, 2026.**

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR FINAL REGISTRATION

Candidates eligible for final registration must submit the documents listed below in person to the Institute of Health Sciences within the announced timeframe.

- 1) For registration to master's degree programs: The original and one photocopy of the bachelor's degree diploma or graduation certificate;
For registration to doctoral degree programs: The originals and one photocopy of both the bachelor's and master's degree diplomas or graduation certificates.
 - Candidates who have graduated from higher education institutions abroad must also submit **Turkish translations** of their diplomas or graduation certificates.
- 2) Original and one photocopy of the transcript(s) showing the grades for all courses taken during undergraduate and/or graduate studies, as well as the graduation GPA (based on a 100-point scale).
 - Candidates who graduated from higher education institutions abroad must submit their transcripts accompanied by a **Turkish translation** and including the GPA calculated on a 100-point scale.

3) A printout of the ALES or equivalent exam result document from the internet. (The validity period of the ALES exam is 5 years.)

- Foreign national candidates are not required to have taken the ALES exam. Instead of ALES, the required score from the GRE exam—which is accepted as equivalent—is sought (if requested by the Department).

4) Online printout of the YDS/YÖKDİL or equivalent exam result document. (For doctoral programs or English-language master's programs) (The validity period for the foreign language certificate is 5 years.)

5) Photocopy of the national ID card (for foreign national candidates: a photocopy of the passport and a document showing the foreign national ID number)

6) For male candidates, a recently dated Military Service Status Certificate obtained from military service branches (**not required for foreign national candidates**).

7) A C1-level "Turkish Proficiency" certificate—or a certified copy thereof—demonstrating Turkish language proficiency for foreign national applicants to Turkish-language programs. (This is not required of foreign national students who have graduated from departments in Turkey where the medium of instruction is Turkish.)

8) For foreign national candidates: A “Diploma Equivalency Certificate” is required for applications to departments involving clinical practice, while a “School Recognition Certificate” is required for applications to programs without clinical practice. (This is not required for students who have graduated from universities in Turkey.)

9) A photocopy of the residence permit document is required for foreign national candidates.

10) To benefit from the 40% employee discount applicable to healthcare workers or civil servants, a signed employment certificate issued by their employing institution must be presented.

11) To benefit from the 40% discount applicable to the relatives of martyrs and veterans, it is necessary to present a document proving one's status as a relative of a martyr or veteran.

12) Students supported under the scholarship program provided by the Provincial Directorate of Health are required to present both the original and a photocopy of the document issued by the Provincial Directorate of Health that verifies their scholarship status.
