

Child Development Education Program for Families in the Earthquake-Affected Region

The “Child Development Education Program for Families in the Earthquake-Affected Region” was implemented in Gaziantep from 14 May to 2 July 2024 for families affected by the earthquakes centred in Kahramanmaraş on 6 February 2023. Conducted in collaboration between the Departments of Child Development at İstanbul Medipol University’s Faculty of Health Sciences and School of Health Sciences and Ayşe Ferhat Yapar Preschool, the project was designed for the families of children attending the preschool.

The eight-week program aimed to raise families’ awareness of child development and child psychology; strengthen effective communication with their children; encourage positive parenting practices; support children’s development through play; and reinforce family relationships. The training sessions addressed parent–child communication, parenting attitudes, emotional and behavioural problems in children, children and play, children’s books, and children’s use of media and technology.

The program was delivered through both face-to-face and online sessions. Face-to-face sessions were held at Ayşe Ferhat Yapar Preschool, while online sessions were conducted via Microsoft Teams. The project was led by Professor Arzu Yükselen and implemented in collaboration with Lecturer Medine Pervin Baysan.
