

ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING STUDENTS' CONTINUATION OF EDUCATION UNDER LAW NO. 7592

Under Provisional Article 85 added to Higher Education Law No. 2547 by Article 14 of Law No. 7592 on Amendments to the Higher Education Law and Certain Laws, which entered into force upon its publication in the Official Gazette No. 33335 dated August 9, 2026, the following provisions have been established regarding the application, registration, adaptation, and other procedures for students who wish to apply to continue their education.

1. Application Date and Method

Students of our Institute whose enrollment has been terminated or will be terminated by December 9, 2026, must apply in person to our Institute by the end of business hours on December 9, 2026.

2. Academic Term for Registration

Applications;

- **If submitted by October 18, 2026, students will be registered for the Fall Semester of the 2026–2027 academic year,**
- **If submitted after October 18, 2026, students will be registered for the Spring Semester of the 2026–2027 academic year**

will be registered.

3. Registration and Course Transfer Procedures

Students whose applications are approved will be registered at the grade level or level of study from which they were withdrawn on the date their enrollment was terminated.

Students are required to pay the announced tuition fees for the 2026–2027 academic year in which they are registered.

4. Procedures for Students in the Thesis Stage

Students who are in the thesis stage or whose theses are ready for submission;

- Provided that they meet the graduation requirements specified in the relevant Graduate Education and Training Regulation,
- Thesis submission, thesis defense, and graduation procedures may be carried out without requiring the minimum period of study.

Attention to Students Applying

Students who wish to apply are kindly requested to pay close attention to the specified dates and application requirements and to submit their applications in person to our Institute by the end of business hours on **December 9, 2026**.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

Candidates who wish to benefit from the amnesty must personally submit the documents listed below to the Institute of Health Sciences.

1) For registration in Master's programs: the original and one photocopy of the bachelor's diploma or graduation certificate;

For registration in Doctoral programs: the original and one photocopy of the bachelor's and master's diplomas or graduation certificates.

- Candidates who have graduated from higher education institutions abroad must also submit Turkish translations of their diplomas or graduation certificates.

2) The original and one photocopy of the transcript showing the grades received for all courses taken during undergraduate and/or graduate studies, as well as the overall graduation grade point average (transcript based on a 100-point grading system).

- Candidates who have graduated from higher education institutions abroad must submit their transcripts together with their Turkish translations, including their grade point average based on a 100-point grading system.

3) ALES or GRE Certificate (Internet printout of an equivalent examination result certificate.)

4) YDS/YÖKDİL or equivalent examination result certificate (internet printout) (for doctoral programs or English-language master's programs).

5) Photocopy of the identity card (for foreign candidates, a document showing the foreigner identification number and a photocopy of the passport).

6) Male candidates must submit a recently issued Military Status Certificate obtained from the military service branches (not required for foreign candidates).

7) Foreign candidates applying to Turkish-language programs must submit an original or certified copy of a C1-level “Turkish Proficiency” certificate demonstrating their proficiency in Turkish. (Not required for foreign students who have graduated from departments in Türkiye where the language of instruction is Turkish.)

8) Foreign candidates: For applications to departments that include clinical practice, a “Diploma Equivalence Certificate” is required; for applications to programs that do not include clinical practice, a “School Recognition Certificate” is required. (Not required for students who have graduated from universities in Türkiye.)

9) Foreign candidates are required to submit a photocopy of their residence permit.

10) Kurum İçi Muafiyet Formu (Internal Exemption Form) (Available on the Forms page of the Institute of Health Sciences.)

11) Students who wish to benefit from the discount rates must submit a current employment certificate, electronically signed or wet-signed by the institution where they work, at the time of application.

_ A 40% discount is offered to healthcare professionals who are not employed by our University, civil servants, and the

_ No discount is available for the Health Management Non-Thesis Master's Program (Distance Education).

_ A 30% discount is applied to group applications consisting of at least 10 people.

_ A 40% discount is offered to graduates of undergraduate programs such as Physics, Physics Engineering, and related fields who apply to the Health Physics Master's Program.

_ The thesis fee is charged only once. No additional fee will be charged if the thesis period is extended.

_ The thesis fee is the fee determined for students who enter the thesis phase in the 2026–2027 academic year. It is subject to an annual increase at the rate determined each year.

_ A 50% discount will be applied only to foreign students who are members of Medipol or graduates of Medipol.

* The total fee is calculated based on 21 credits, including the thesis fee for thesis-based master's and doctoral programs, and 30 credits for non-thesis master's programs. (The program fee will increase as the number of course credits taken increases.)

Note: An individual may benefit from only the highest applicable discount rate.
