

Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) Application Announcement

1. What is a Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)?

A Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) consists of short and intensive educational programmes that use innovative teaching and training methods, including online collaboration. These programmes may involve problem- and solution-oriented learning, where multinational and multidisciplinary groups work together to develop solutions to issues related to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals or other social issues identified by regions, cities, or companies. Blended Intensive Programmes aim to reach students from different cultural, social, and economic backgrounds, from all fields of study and study cycles, through a new and more flexible mobility format that combines physical mobility with online education.

2. Who Can Apply for This Announcement and What Are the Application Requirements?

Applications from students in the two programmes specified under this announcement will be accepted.

- Students enrolled as full-time students in the Bachelor's Degree Programme in **Speech and Language Therapy at the Faculty of Health Sciences**, Istanbul Medipol University may apply for the BIP mobility titled Minor in Multilingualism.
- Students enrolled as full-time students in one of the Bachelor's degree programmes in **International Trade and Finance, Management Information Systems, or Business Administration** at the Faculty of Business and Management Sciences, Istanbul Medipol University may apply for the BIP mobility titled Artificial Intelligence Literacy and Applications in Business and Management.
- The General Academic Grade Point Average (GPA) must be at least **2.20/4.00**.

3. When and Where Can Applications Be Submitted?

Applications will start on **24 August 2026** and will end on **8 September 2026**. Applications must be submitted via <https://turnaportal.ua.gov.tr/> using an e-Government password. All candidates wishing to apply must have an e-Government password. Application steps and detailed information are provided in the application guide. 4. Duration of the Activity

This call consists of physical mobility supported by a mandatory virtual component. The duration of the physical mobility is **5 (five)** days. Students participating in the mobility will be awarded **3 ECTS** upon successful completion of the programme.

5. Foreign Language Examination

The English language examination to be conducted to assess foreign language proficiency will be held in two stages **on Thursday, 10 September** (written examination and speaking examination). Detailed information regarding the examination will also be announced separately on our official website.

6. What Are the Evaluation Criteria?

Students who meet the minimum application requirements will be evaluated out of 100 points and ranked starting from the highest score. 1

Evaluation criteria:

- Academic achievement level (GPA): **50%**
- Foreign language level: **50%**

Additional points/deductions affecting the final score:

- Children of martyrs and veterans: **+15 points**
- Students with disabilities (provided that they are documented): **+10 points**
- Students who have previously or currently been under a protection, care, or accommodation decision within the scope of Law No. 2828 on Social Services and Law No. 5395 on Child Protection: **+10 points**
- Students themselves or their first-degree relatives (biological/step) who have received disaster victim assistance from AFAD: **+10 points**
- Participating in mobility in the country of which the student is a citizen: **–10 points**
- Having previously benefited from the same project type within the same study cycle (with or without a grant): **–10 points**
- Not participating in the mobility despite being selected, without submitting a withdrawal notification within the specified period: **–10 points**

7. When and Where Will the Application Results Be Announced?

The mobility application results will be announced **no later than 25 September 2026** on the official website of Istanbul Medipol University and the official website of the Erasmus Institutional Coordination Office.

8. Mobility Location and Dates

- For students of the **Speech and Language Therapy Department**, the physical mobility will be carried out at **Istanbul Medipol University between 9–13 November 2026**. Detailed information regarding the mobility process will be shared separately with the selected students.
- For students in the **Business and Management Sciences field**, the physical mobility will be carried out at **Istanbul Medipol University between 7–12 December 2026**. Detailed information regarding the mobility process will be shared separately with the selected students.

9. Withdrawal

Students who have been selected for the Blended Intensive Programme mobility but wish to withdraw from participation or waive the financial support must complete a withdrawal petition and submit it to erasmus@medipol.edu.tr by **17:00 on 1 October 2026**. Students who do not submit their withdrawal notification within the specified period will have 10 points deducted from their total score in their application in the following year.
