APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A student may apply to a **Double Major Diploma Program** at the earliest at the beginning of the **3rd semester** and at the latest at the beginning of the **5th semester** of the undergraduate program in which they are currently enrolled.
- In order to apply to a Double Major Diploma Program, the student must meet the following requirements:
 - The student must have taken all compulsory courses in their registered undergraduate program up to the semester in which they are applying and must have successfully completed all courses taken.
 - The student's cumulative grade point average (CGPA) at the time of application must be:
 - At least **3.13 (80/100)** for students applying from the **Faculty of Fine Arts, Design and Architecture**.
 - At least **3.00 (76.66/100)** for students applying from **other faculties**.

- c) The student must be ranked within the **top 20%** of their class in terms of academic achievement in the relevant year of their undergraduate program.
- d) Students who are not within the top 20% in terms of academic ranking may apply provided that their university entrance score is **not lower than the base score of the Double Major Program for the relevant year**.
- e) For **English-medium programs**, applicants are required to provide proof of English language proficiency, such as **TOEFL, YDS, etc.**, together with a document confirming that the certificate is recognized by the University's School of Languages, or a certificate of achievement obtained from the University's School of Languages.
- f) For the **Architecture** and **Architecture (English)** programs, candidates whose university placement ranking is **250,000 or lower** are **not eligible to apply** for the Double Major Program.
3. The special requirements of the programs shall be determined in accordance with the **protocols established between the respective departments**.
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* Admission is conditional upon successfully passing the **Special Aptitude Examination** administered by the department following the application.

** Applications must be submitted **in person to the department secretariat**. Applications submitted by **e-mail or courier/mail will not be accepted**.
