

**COURSE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR THE FALL SEMESTER OF THE
2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR**

Course selection for the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 academic year will be carried out on MEBIS between September 16 – September 26, 2025.

Important:

- **If you have any outstanding tuition fees, the courses you select on MEBIS cannot be assigned to your account.**
- **Since courses you have selected cannot be assigned to your account until your debt is cleared, you must contact the Student Accounting Unit of the Department of Administrative and Financial Affairs to resolve the issue.**

Course Registration Details

- **Compulsory Courses:** Courses required for graduation.
- **Common Compulsory Courses** (Turkish Language I and II / Atatürk's Principles and History of Reforms I and II)
- **Program-Related Elective Courses:** Elective courses taken in upper classes.
- **Optional Elective Courses** (General Culture, Hobbies, etc.)
- Courses from Other Departments
- Courses/Internships You Have Failed

On the **Course Selection Screen**, under the headings above, you will find the courses to be offered at our faculty during the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 academic year, the internships to be provided, as well as the courses/internships you are required to retake due to failure.

First-year students must select **Common Compulsory Courses**.

Among the compulsory courses, **Turkish Language I and II** and **Atatürk's Principles and History of Reforms I and II** will be offered via distance education (UZEM).

Students who wish to take **Optional Elective Courses** must select from the courses listed under the **Optional Elective Courses** heading. These courses will be offered at the **Kavacık and Haliç Campuses** during the Fall semester of the 2025-2026 academic year, and students will be placed according to available quotas; therefore, preferences should be made accordingly. An **Optional Elective Course** that was previously taken and passed can only be reselected for the purpose of **improving the grade**.

K/P-2: Course held at **Kavacık Campus / Thursday**

K/CTS-1: Course held at **Kavacık Campus / Saturday**

H/C-2: Course held at **Haliç Campus / Friday**

H/CTS-1: Course held at **Haliç Campus / Saturday**.

If an Optional Elective Course selected under the “**Failed Courses**” tab is not offered, and you select another course during the **course add/drop period**, the system will match it with the failed course. Your responsibility will then apply to the new course, and you will have no obligation regarding the previous one.

The validity of the course registration depends on the course selection being approved by both the **student** and the **advisor**.

You cannot attend any course or practice sessions or take their exams without registering for the course. Writing your name manually on the class list and attending does not mean that you have selected the course; it has no validity whatsoever.

Optional Elective	It is recommended to select the course labeled K/P-2 . Since the exams for elective courses are held on the same day and time as the course itself, no other exams will be scheduled for first-year students during that day and time slot. Otherwise, if you choose courses offered on different days and campuses, all responsibility will rest with the student. Since the exams for those courses will also be held on their respective days and times, there is a possibility of a conflict with the exams of the faculty's compulsory courses.			

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Turkish citizens enrolled in the English Program of our faculty are required to select the Turkish Language-I (TDL1110200) and Atatürk's Principles and History of Reforms-I (ATA1110800) courses from the Turkish Program (to be selected under the “Courses from Other Departments” tab). **The same applies for the spring semester** (Turkish Language-II, Atatürk's Principles and History of Reforms-II); these courses must also be selected from those offered in the Turkish Program.

Course Exemption Procedures

- After the course registration process is completed, students may request an exemption for equivalent courses previously taken and successfully completed at other higher education institutions (requests other than transfer applications). These requests must be submitted **in person to the Faculty Secretariat**. Applications sent by mail or email will be considered invalid.
- Students must list **all courses stated on their transcript that they believe they can be exempt from**, regardless of the semester or academic year. Exemptions are **not processed on a semester basis**.

- Mid-term exemption requests are not accepted, except for **Double Major Program students who are in a graduation status**.
- Documents related to the courses for which exemption is requested (**official transcript, course descriptions**) must be submitted to the Dean's Office along with the **Exemption Application Form** (The form must be completely filled out, including the codes, ECTS credits, and grades of the courses previously taken and passed, and for which exemption is requested. Students requesting exemptions for a large number of courses may print multiple copies of the form).
- Until the exemption process is finalized, students are required to attend the relevant course.
- If the exemption process is completed by the end of the add/drop period (October 3, 2025), the student may register for a new course(s) deemed appropriate by the Academic Advisor.
- Applications submitted after the deadline will not be processed.

This is an important announcement for our students.
