





## Final Score Announcement for Erasmus 2025-26 Project

- 1. Within the scope of the 2025 KA 131 Mobility, the "Final Score Results" calculated according to the evaluation criteria specified in the Erasmus+ Program Guide and detailed below are as follows.
- 2. These results only indicate the final scores and do not constitute the grant allocation results. Grants are finalized after the annual contribution agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Türkiye is signed, and this agreement has not yet been concluded. Once this agreement is signed, a grant contract will be signed between the Turkish National Agency and Istanbul Medipol University, finalizing the amount of grant allocated to our university. After the grant amount allocated to our university is determined, a separate announcement will be made regarding the grant distribution.
- 3. The criteria and weighted score calculations used to evaluate mobility applications are as follows:
- Academic achievement level (GPA): 50% (out of a total of 100 points)
- Language proficiency: 50% (out of a total of 100 points)

## The minimum passing score for the Erasmus exam is 70.

Additional Score Criteria:

- Children of martyrs and veterans: +15 points
- Students with disabilities (subject to documented proof): +10 points
- Students under protection, care, or shelter orders under Law No. 2828 on Social Services: +10 points
- Submission of an acceptance letter at the time of application for internship mobility: +10 points
- Students or their first-degree relatives receiving disaster aid from AFAD: +10 points
- Internships aimed at developing digital skills (DOTs): +5 points
- Application within the scope of mandatory internships: +5 points
- Previous participation in the same project (with or without a grant): -10 points
- Participation in mobility in the country of citizenship: -10 points
- Failure to participate in mobility without timely withdrawal notification despite being selected: -10 points
- Simultaneous application for two types of mobility (applied reduction to the applicant's preferred mobility type): -10 points
- Unexcused absence from meetings/trainings organized by the university regarding mobility (applied if reapplying for Erasmus): -5 points
- Declaring participation in the language exam but failing to attend without a valid excuse (applied if reapplying for Erasmus): -5 points







- 4. The "Placement Results" for the 2025 contract period will be announced on March 28, 2025.
- 5. Students benefiting from internship mobility within the 2025 contract period must submit their internship acceptance letters (invitation letters) to erasmus@medipol.edu.tr by November 30, 2025, at 23:59.
- 6. Students who wish to appeal their foreign language exam results may do so within 3 business days from the announcement of the results by submitting an appeal to the Secretariat of the General Coordination of Foreign Languages. Students wishing to appeal must complete the exam appeal form and send it via email to ptkavak@medipol.edu.tr. The General Coordination of Foreign Languages will evaluate the request, and in case of a change in the result, both the student and the Erasmus Coordination Office will be informed. <u>Click here</u> to access the form.
- 7. Students who wish to benefit from the Erasmus program before the grant amount is determined must participate in the program without a grant. At this stage, students are solely responsible for their expenses, and the university or our office cannot be held liable for any costs incurred.
